Forklift training and certification that is provided by the employers is typically facilitated by an on-site manager. A performance test happens at the end of the program. If successful, the trainee will be given a certification card.

An alternative to employer-provided training involves enrolling in a program at an industrial equipment or forklift certification training school. Trainees receive practical instruction on different models of forklifts. Safety procedures are a major focus of the training. A written test and driving test must be successfully finished before a lift truck certification card is issued.
