Course materials consist of load exercises and load charts for the crane with which the individual training is working.

Optional testing mechanisms are provided for all of our courses. Students will usually write tests both prior to and following training. A test for skills is generally administered for programs that comprise H.O.S.T. People training would be graded and tested.

We offer certified training programs for the following cranes: Fixed and Swing Cab Mobile Hydraulic Cranes; Lattice Boom/Crawler Cranes; Rigging / Signalperson Certification and Training; Articulated Boom / Knuckleboom Cranes; Testing & Certification; and In-The-Seat Training.
